In the last few months, we are seeing more and more fraudulent emails trying to get individuals to click on links asking for passwords and personal information!!

These emails at first glance seem real. When receiving all emails which ask you to click on a link, double check the email address that the email has been sent from. This will tell you definitively if it's real or not. The email is located in these angled brackets <> and as you can see in both of these examples that the email addresses are neither of the companies they are claiming to be.

If you are still unsure, we strongly recommend forwarding the email to our helpdesk before you click on it.

For the time being, we advise you NOT to install Windows 11. We will inform you when you are able to do this.

Password Security

One of the most common ways a hacker can break into your computer, email etc is by guessing your password. Simple passwords enable hackers to gain access and control of your device easily.

See the below chart of how long it would take a hacker to crack your password.



We suggest making sure your password a minimum of 10 characters long including at least one uppercase letter + number + symbol and where possible turning on 2 Factor Authentication (2FA).
